

Dear Mrs. Jennings:

The Kingsway Prison Ministry has given me the ability to recognize God's Holy Spirit within me, and His blessings upon me. On my own I've lived every imaginable lifestyle. I became as Superman and survived seven (7) years of prison as a forgotten men; I used resilience to rose and fall like a break-making man; and only recently through Kingsway recognized God's purpose for life. The river of life had capsized my canoe. How many fixes have we tried? Doctors, lawyers, and psychologists never address the problem. I already knew everything about everywhere but nothing about my strengths and resources. I reached out blindly and touched nothing until Kingsway placed my hands in God's capable hands. The Lord confirmed the first and second commandments to me, just as Jesus said to the Pharisees. We've known the commandments for years. Have we lived, used, heard, or believed in them, or allowed the commandments to direct our lives? Usually only when it was convenient.

Kingsway helped me find knowledge, understanding, and wisdom in God and in myself. Everyone's life has purpose, meaning, and the choice to run wild or maintain self-control and discipline. I've got peace and security while sitting amongst a den of lions. Satan roams everyday but my trust in our Lord has encompassed me with the "Whole Armor of God" and I fear no more. My Lord is working miracles through my friends, and before God saved me I had no friends. Now I've got a life, a whole lot of hope, and a purpose. Kingsway gave me the key to a fulfilling life and tools to live responsibly with God as my Father and my guide to success.

The ministry has given me study materials of the Word, meditation, and prayer. And the abundance of WISDOM I have now is directly attributed to God, through His Holy Spirit as He guides Kingsway and flls the need for love in my life. The ministry has indirectly given me the nickname "Wisdom" because I share gifts God has provided to me, and I also lead some Bible study services.

I may be delayed, but I'll never be denied the Kingdom of Our Lord.

THE COLOR PURPLE

Think of when you are sad or down, and you say I feel blue. Humanity is inherently weak and unable to avoid negative, detrimental behavior when left to ourselves. We will satisfy our own fleshly desires, and earthly lusts. Therefore, we need the mixture of the red of the blood of Jesus Christ with our blue color of our human side. When the blue mixes with the red, it creates a beautiful new color, one that can only be achieved by mixing two primary colors. Man needs God. In order for us to achieve our ultimate

purpose, we need to add the red with our blue. That is when the beautiful color of purple appears! And that is when we can see the function of our purpose being realized. That beautiful color points us toward our destiny. But it also always serves as a reminder that it could never be achieved without God. Our purpose is not just to be happy, or stay sober, or stay out of trouble. Our purpose is to infuse our human testimony (blue) with the red of the power of the message of the cross to allow our lives to be a living example of the power of God, still operating in the earth today. That is how we walk in the power and authority given to us by God. That is how we defeat the devil! That is the power of purple.







Since writing the story about Jeremy last month, he has received the help he needs. Kingsway is receiving requests concerning his recovery, so this is what we know now. Jeremy is doing well and no longer must wear the bulky hot back brace; however, he still has therapy 3 times a week. He has been blessed with a vehicle to use and his rent is taken care of, but he is bored with not being able to work or do the things he enjoys. He is staying clear of drugs and is alcohol free, and he really wants to work. His doctors have said he can work a simple office type job part time. If anyone knows of something they think he can do, please let Kingsway know. He now has a good attorney that is working with him and the young man that caused the accident has now admitted guilt. That's another whole story Jeremy will have to deal with, and he is asking for prayer. He said he is so glad that he knows Jesus and is using his downtime now to learn more about the Bible. He is attending Kingsway's Sunday afternoon gatherings and says they really help him to know he now has a wonderful family at Kingsway, and he feels love he has never known before. Sharing the love of Jesus is what we do. The first 7 days in September we helped 8 returning citizens with everything from a room in Oxford House to phones and hygiene kits. Please keep us in prayer as we look forward to our Christmas projects.
